- What accusations were brought by some of the people? What aspects of the Old Law applied to this issue, and how did Nehemiah react? (Neh 5: 1 – 6)
- What actions did Nehemiah take to address the situation? (Neh 5: 7 – 9)
- What example did Nehemiah set, and what direction did he give to the people to resolve the situation? (Neh 5: 10, 11)
- What did the people do, and how did Nehemiah respond? (Neh 5: 12, 13)
- What had Nehemiah done to help ease the people's burdens? (Neh 5: 14 – 16)
- Describe the sustenance that Nehemiah provided regularly for his people. (Neh 5: 17 – 19)
