- What did Nehemiah perceive regarding this man's intentions? What did the Samaritans hope to achieve, and how did Nehemiah respond to the plot? (Neh 6: 12 – 14)
- What was the end result of the people's work? (Neh 6: 15, 16)
- What relationships did some Jews have with Tobiah? What issues resulted? (Neh 6: 17 – 19)
- Summarize lessons we can learn from this chapter about how to deal with those who oppose God's work.
