## **Worshiping in Truth: Sunday, August 14**

- What is the purpose of worship? (Psalm 95: 6 – 7; Hebrews 10: 24 – 25)
- From Jesus' conversation with the Samaritan woman as recorded in John Chapter 4, what does it mean to worship in truth? (John 4: 23 – 24; Acts 17: 22 – 24)
- How would you define doctrine? How does this apply to worship? (Titus 1: 9; Titus 2: 1; Hebrews 12: 28; Matthew 15: 7 – 9)
- On what day of the week are we directed to worship? (Matthew 28: 1; Acts 20: 7; 1 Corinthians 16: 2)
- Where did early Christians gather to worship? (Romans 16: 5; Acts 19: 8 – 9)

## **Worshiping in Spirit: Wednesday, August 17**

- What does it mean to worship in spirit? (John 4: 23 – 24; 1 Chron. 16: 29)
- Explain some basic differences between worship under the Old Law and worship within the New Covenant. What do those differences indicate about God's relationship with us, and His intent for worship? (1 Cor. 3: 16 – 17; Romans 12: 1 – 2; Matthew 9: 13; Hebrews 13: 15)
- What attitude should we have when we worship together? (Psalm 29: 2; Psalm 95: 1 – 2; Psalm 96: 9)
- How do we prepare for worship?
