

A Study of Psalm 119 ~ Verses 25 - 40

(25 – 26) How does the author describe his condition in **verse 25**? Consider and describe the statement and request made by the author in **verse 26**. What can we learn about our relationship with God? (*Philippians 4: 6 – 7*)

(27 – 28) How does the author expand upon his situation, and what solution will he employ to remedy his condition? (*Proverbs 3: 5 – 6*)

(29 – 30) Considering the psalmist's comments in this passage, describe his focus on honesty. What connection does he make between honesty and having a knowledge of God's word?

(31 – 32) How does the author describe his attachment to God's word? In **verse 32**, what does the author mean when he states that God would "enlarge his heart"? (*1 Corinthians 9: 24 – 27*)

(33 – 34) Consider and describe how God teaches us His way. What is the intended outcome of the understanding that the author requests in **verse 34**?

(35 – 36) Describe the psalmist's requests as articulated in this passage. How does a knowledge of God's word help us to avoid covetousness (or selfish / dishonest gain)? (*1 John 2: 15 – 17*)

(37 – 38) From **verse 37**, consider and describe the author's reference to looking at "worthless things". What can we learn from the author's request? (*Matthew 6: 22 – 23; Philippians 4: 8 – 9*)

(39 – 40) Describe the situation as articulated by the psalmist in this passage. What is the reproach (or disgrace) that he refers to in **verse 39**, and what acknowledgments does he make regarding the power of God's word? (*2 Timothy 3: 12 – 15*)
