

# A Study of Psalm 119 ~ Verses 9 - 24

**(9 – 10)** Describe the question posed in **verse 9**. What answer is provided, and how can we apply that answer to strengthen our understanding of God's word? (*Amos 8: 11 – 13*)

**(11 – 12)** How do we hide (treasure or store) God's word in our hearts, and what is the result? (*Proverbs 4: 20 – 22*)

**(13 – 14)** What action is described in **verse 13**, and how can we imitate that action? What does **verse 14** indicate regarding how we should value God's word?

**(15 – 16)** What does it mean to meditate (or reflect) on God's word? What is the value of this type of reflection?

**(17 – 18)** What does the author ask of God? What can we learn from that example? (*1 John 1: 6 – 7*)

**(19 – 20)** How does the author describe his situation in this world, and how can we relate to his observations? Describe the author's attitude toward God's word. (*Philippians 3: 20; 1 Peter 2: 11*)

**(21 – 22)** What comparisons does the author make? What are the benefits and potential risks associated with those types of comparisons? (*Romans 8: 31 – 33*)

**(23 – 24)** What can we learn and apply regarding our response to challenges that we face from other people? (*Romans 8: 38 – 39*)
