(105 – 106) Describe the illustration that the author provides in **verse 105**. According to **verse 106**, how does he respond to that illustration?
(Matthew 5: 14 – 16)

(107 – 108) What situation does the author describe in **verse 107**? As a result, what requests does the psalmist make?
(John 4: 23 – 24; Romans 12: 1)

(109 – 110) How does the author articulate his situation, and how does he respond? What lesson does he provide based on his response to the challenges that he faces? *(2 Corinthians 12: 9 – 10)*

(111 – 112) According to **verse 111**, how does the psalmist describe the impact of God's word? What does he teach in **verse 112** regarding the importance of faithful obedience to God's word? *(Romans 8: 16 – 17)*

(113 – 114) What lessons does the author impart regarding the power of God's word to help us navigate the challenges and hardships of life, especially those presented by people he describes as "double-minded"?

(115 – 116) What statement does the psalmist make regarding our relationships with those he refers to as "evildoers"? What subsequent request does he make in **verse 116**? *(2 Corinthians 6: 14)*

(117 – 118) In **verse 117**, what request does the psalmist make? In **verse 118**, how does he describe God's response to those who do not abide by His word?

(119 – 120) How does the author continue to describe God's response to those who are unfaithful, and what impact does that realization have on him? What does he teach us about our attitude regarding God's word, and the consequences of disbelief and / or disobedience? *(Hebrews 10: 26 – 27)*
