

# A Study of Psalm 119 ~ Verses 121 - 136

**(121 – 122)** In **verse 121**, what point does the author make about our relationship with God? What is the meaning of the request that he makes in **verse 122**? (*2 Corinthians 1: 20*)

**(123 – 124)** From **verse 123**, what does the psalmist teach us about our dedication to learning God's word? In **verse 124**, what is the connection between God's mercy / graciousness and His willingness to teach us His word? (*Ephesians 2: 4 – 7*)

**(125 – 126)** Describe the meaning of the author's requests. From **verse 126**, what action does the author ask God to take?

**(127 – 128)** What does the author teach us about the value of God's word? What is the outcome of this realization for the author, and what can we learn from his observation? (*Psalm 33: 4 – 5*)

**(129 – 130)** How does the psalmist describe God's word in **verse 129**, and how does the psalmist respond? From **verse 130**, describe the meaning and outcome of the author's statement regarding the "entrance (or unfolding)" of God's word. (*John 8: 12*)

**(131 – 132)** What does the author teach us about our desire for God's word, and how does he describe God's mercy toward those who faithfully serve Him? (*Psalm 42: 1 – 2*)

**(133 – 134)** Describe the requests that the psalmist makes in **verse 133**. What is the intended outcome of the request that he makes in **verse 134**?

**(135 – 136)** What does the author ask of the Lord in **verse 135**? From **verse 136**, what is the author's response to the lack of faithful obedience to God's word that he observes, and what can we learn from his response? (*Psalm 42: 3*)
