(89 – 90) What point does the psalmist make about God's eternal power and the glory of His creation? How do we know of God's power and creation?
(John 1: 1 – 3)

(91 – 92) What does the author say about the longevity of God's word and the purpose of His creation? In **verse 92**, what point does the author make regarding the value of our faith in God's word? *(Romans 1: 20)*

(93 – 94) Based on the psalmist's observations, how does an understanding of God's word enable us to cultivate a meaningful relationship with the Lord?

(95 – 96) From **verse 95**, how can our knowledge of God's word help us to overcome hardship and challenges? In **verse 96**, what observation does the author make about the power and scope of God's word?

(97 – 98) How does the psalmist respond to his love for God's word, and how can that response help to overcome the effects of persecution?
(Proverbs 11: 8 – 9)

(99 – 100) How does the author contrast worldly knowledge with a true understanding of God's word? How can we relate to his observation?
(Colossians 2: 8 – 10)

(101 – 102) How can knowledge of God's word help us to defend against temptation? In **verse 102**, what does the author say about the importance of obedience? *(Psalm 86: 11)*

(103 – 104) How does the psalmist describe the power of God's word? From **verse 104**, what is the outcome of an understanding of God's commandments? *(James 3: 13 – 17)*
