- (155 156) According to **verse 155**, why is salvation "far from the wicked"? What is the connection between the topic of salvation and the point that the author makes in **verse 156** regarding God's mercy? (*Ephesians 2: 4 5*)
- (157 158) What is the psalmist's reaction to those who persecute him and lack faith in God's word?
- (159 160) In verse 159, what does the author say about our relationship with God? What points does he make about God's word in verse 160? (Isaiah 40: 8)
- **(161 162)** What observations does the psalmist share regarding the ability of God's word to help us navigate challenging situations? How should we respond when we encounter persecution, even from those with worldly power and authority? (Romans 8: 37 39)
- (163 164) What statement does the author make in **verse 163** regarding the topic of dishonesty? In **verse 164**, what is the significance of the reference to the number seven, and what does that indicate about our focus on praising God? (Colossians 3: 9 10; Psalm 34: 1 3)
- (165 166) What is the outcome for those who love God's word, and how does the author respond? What does the psalmist say regarding our focus on salvation?
- (167 168) According to verse 167, how does the author feel about God's word? What does he reveal in verse 168 about God's knowledge of our thoughts, actions and motivations? (Hebrews 4: 12 13)
