(173 – 174) In verse 173, what does the author request from God, and what is the basis for his request? From verse 174, what effect does God's word have on the psalmist?

(175 – 176) What does the author ask of God in **verse 175**, and what action does the author pledge in response? What confession does the author make in **verse 176**, and what does he ask from God as a result of this acknowledgement? *(Isaiah 53: 6; Luke 19: 10)*
