

Knowing God: God's Knowledge and Wisdom

God's Knowledge (Omniscience):

- What does it mean that God is “omniscient”? How would you describe God’s knowledge? (*Psalm 147: 5*)
- What evidence do we have that demonstrates God’s knowledge? (*Psalm 139: 1 – 4*)
- How does God’s knowledge benefit us, and how should we respond to this attribute? (*Psalm 119: 66; Proverbs 18: 15*)
- How would you describe the difference between God’s knowledge and His wisdom? What is the connection between these two attributes?

God's Wisdom:

- Consider these characteristics of God’s wisdom:
 - His wisdom is perfect. (*Isaiah 28: 29*)
 - His wisdom surpasses ours. (*Isaiah 55: 8 – 9; Romans 11: 33*)
 - God gives us wisdom. (*Proverbs 2: 6*)
- Describe some ways that we can “get wisdom”. (*Proverbs 4: 5; Proverbs 2: 4 – 5; James 1: 5; Proverbs 13: 20*)
- What is the difference between worldly wisdom and Godly wisdom? As we seek to develop Godly wisdom, why does God teach us to “become a fool”? (*1 Cor 3: 18*)
